The Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) is an opportunity for adult learners who, for whatever reason, did not complete or achieve their Grade 12/matric during their high school years. This programme can also be completed by learners who would like to improve their marks or complete subjects that they did not take in their Grade 12 year. The programme is open to adult learners who are 21 years of age and have completed and, at a minimum passed a Grade 9 qualification. The ASC makes use of the CAPS curriculum and the final qualification is awarded by Umalusi and the Department of Basic Education.

ELIGIBILITY TO STUDY

The application requirements for UCT Online High School for Adult Matric as follows:

1. Be 21 years old when writing the ASC examinations and have a Valid South African Identity Document or a study permit (foreign nationals).
2. The learner is responsible for confirming they are eligible to write the ASC exam and for registering to write the ASC exam with the Department of Education (see requirements [here](#))

There is NO formal Admissions Assessment.

We will accept foreign nationals provided that they can produce the required documents. The onus is on them to comply with visa requirements from the SA Department of Home Affairs. There are specific criteria for admission to study at UCT Online High School, please refer to our Admissions Policy which outlines all the criteria for admission.

WHAT SUBJECTS ARE AVAILABLE?

The UCT Online High School Adult Matric preparation programme offers 11 subjects. The subjects are as follows:

1. English Home Language
2. Afrikaans First Additional Language
3. IsiXhosa First Additional Language
4. Business Studies
5. Economics
6. Geography
7. History
8. Mathematics
9. Maths Literacy
10. Physical Sciences (requires Pure Mathematics)
11. Life Sciences

Please note that to qualify for an Amended Senior Certificate, it is compulsory to complete **six subjects**, two of which must be a Home Language and a First Additional Language.

WHAT DO I NEED TO ACHIEVE IF I WANT TO GO TO UNIVERSITY AFTER COMPLETING THE ASC?

To gain admission to a university in South Africa with an Amended Senior Certificate (ASC), you'll need to meet specific admission criteria, which can vary depending on the university and the program you are interested in. Here are some general guidelines:

- **Passing Grades:** Typically, universities require you to pass with certain minimum grades. Most commonly, this includes passing:
 - a. At least three subjects at 40% or higher, one of which must be an official language at Home Language level.
 - b. Two additional subjects at 30%, one of which must be an official language at First Additional Language or Home Language level.
 - c. A subminimum of 20% in the sixth subject.
- **Bachelor's Pass Requirements:** For more competitive programs or for bachelor's degree studies, universities often require what's known as a Bachelor's Pass. This usually means higher performance in your matric subjects, sometimes requiring a pass of 50% or more in four subjects
- **Specific Subject Requirements:** Certain university programs may have specific subject requirements. For example, engineering or medical faculties usually require you to have passed subjects like Mathematics and Physical Sciences with higher marks.
- **National Benchmark Tests (NBTs):** Some universities also require the National Benchmark Tests. These assess academic readiness for university study and may be used to complement your ASC results.
- **Additional Requirements:** Universities might consider other factors such as extra curricular activities, leadership roles, and personal statements, especially for competitive programs.

It's important to check directly with the universities you are interested in for their specific requirements. University websites and admission offices can provide detailed information tailored to their application processes and standards.



AMENDED SENIOR CERTIFICATE (ASC) EXAMINATIONS

The Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) Examinations are facilitated, and marked by the DBE. Registrations for these external examinations must be done by the adult learner either in-person or online with the closest Provincial Department of Education. Examinations are written in person at examination venues determined by the DBE in May/June each year.

Reminder: The learner is responsible for confirming they are eligible to write the ASC exam and for registering to write the ASC exam with the Department of Education (see requirements [here](#))

LEARNER EXPECTATIONS

Adult Matric learners take complete ownership of their academic journey and take responsibility for working through their content before the May/June ASC examinations.

The number of hours required will depend on:

1. The learner's start date and amount of time to the May/June ASC exams
2. The bundle (i.e number of subjects) they have selected
3. Their previous academic experience

More subjects = more time required to study each week.

We expect our Adult Matric learners to have:

- Time to study each week
- A high level of self-motivation and good work ethic
- A good understanding of how to use technology and work online with the required platforms.
- Be able to upload and submit documents on the Online Campus as and when required

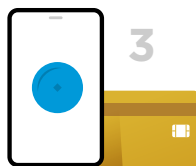
